#### European Championships Title

Finals will be run to determine the European Champion in the Youth, Amateur, and Open classes. The starters in the finals need to qualify in the doubly rated AQHA show for the European Championship (hereinafter called "Go-round"). The starters for the finals are determined by summing up the scores. In order to qualify for the finals, the horse-rider-combination must not be disqualified (for example score of 0) in either of the two shows.

The number of finalists depends on the number of starters in the Go-round.

25 and more	15 finalists
20-24	12 finalists
15-19	10 finalists
9-14	8 finalists
5-8	all competitors are in the final

#### Judging the finals

There will be two judges in the finals. Each judge will score the competitors independently of the other judge and determine the order of placement till place 15. Individual scores and placements will be passed on for subsequent evaluation to the European Championships' show management. Both scores will be summed up and lead to the final placing results.

What happens if summed up scores result in a tie? If the summed-up scores result in a tie for places one to three, there will be a ride-off until the winner is identified.

All remaining ties will be determined by tie-breaker judges. Judge number 1 is the first tiebreaker. If the scores of judge number 1 for the horses in the tie are equal, judge number 2 will be the tiebreaker. The show management will specify and announce the sequence order of the tiebreaker judges. If the tie cannot be "broken" by the tiebreaker judges, it will be left unbroken and makes up the final result.

### **Großwinkelmann Ranch Riding, High-Price Reining, Western Horsemanship, Western Riding:**

The best 6 competitors of the qualifiers qualify for the finals of the Großwinkelmann Ranch Riding, open to all breeds, as well as for the High-Price Reining, High-Price Horsemanship, High-Price Western Riding classes. Qualification is decided based on the scores. The finals will be a new start with all competitors starting with the same score. Prize money will be distributed amongst the finalists according to the DQHA prize money key.

### **Evening agenda:**

Every competition number receives 2 competitor ribbons/bracelets that entitle the owner to buy grandstand seats at a preferential price of € 5,00. These can be claimed either for the Cow Horse Night on Friday or the Gala Night on Saturday. **The number of seats is limited!** Distribution will happen according to the order of entries. Reservations of tickets at a preferential price is guaranteed only if the registration is accompanied by the entry form. **Entry closing date: July 3rd, 2022. Trainers are strongly recommended to make their reservations for the evening shows together with their clients as soon as possible.**

**Whether the evening shows can be held as planned in front of an audience depends on the Corona situation along with the then valid official requirements during the Show period. We will keep you posted on the situation.**

**If you bought and paid for any tickets of the evening shows, we will return 100% of the deposited funds should the shows not take place.**

### **General terms & conditions for the Show:**

The Show is covered by the rules and specifications of the current AQHA and EWU rule books respectively as well as by the following terms:

- Entry confirmations will be sent by email. **Please provide your email address in the entry form!!!**
- Up to the entry closing date entry fees will be 100% refunded. After entry closing date half of the entry fees may be refunded on presentation of a medical certificate. Box money is refunded only if the reserved box can be rented to another party. Office charges are not refundable.
- Should the Show be canceled due to the Covid situation (cancellation will be made public no later than the entry closing date) 100% of the entry fees, box money and office charge will be refunded. After the entry closing date, entry fees and box money will be fully refunded. Office charge will be reimbursed at 50%.
- Please see our website under [www.circle-l.de](http://www.circle-l.de) for Special notes and requirements due to COVID-19.
- The organizer reserves the right to modify the schedule before the closing date, to move the event or to cancel classes by returning the deposit, if special circumstances should so require. The right to change the show schedule is reserved to the show management. Changes to the show schedule do not confer the right to reclaim entry fees.
- Walk Trot classes are restricted to riders who do not compete in respective Canter classes in this show.
- Competitors of AQHA Pleasure or Walk Trot Pleasure classes are not allowed to enter into AQHA Ranch Riding classes. See AQHA rule book 2022 SHW416.2.
- When showing in the AQHA Ranch Trail, showing in the AQHA Trail is not allowed. Again, see AQHA rule book 2022 SHW420.1.
- CL Beginner Ranch Riding: All horses of all ages and all riders with or without club membership who do not compete in other Ranch Riding classes are allowed to enter. Horses in this class can be shown either one-handed in a curb bit or two-handed in a snaffle bit or hackamore (bosal) and riders can show horses that are not self-, or family owned. All L1 (Novice) riders showing in the AQHA Pleasure classes may also show their horses in the CL Beginner Ranch Riding, open to all breeds, as this class is not AQHA approved.
- To start in the lead-line class riders must wear a helmet. Additional stirrups for children who do not reach the normal stirrups are recommended.
- The show management reserves the right to combine the AQHA Amateur and Youth Halter classes "2-year-old & under" and "3-year-old & over" shouldn't there be at least 3 competitors per class.
- All horses must be free of contagious diseases and come from a stable free of epidemic/contagious diseases.
- All horses participating in the Show must be vaccinated at the time of the Show and immunized against influenza. The date of the last vaccination against influenza must have taken place no more than 6 months and 21 prior to the show.
- The horse passport (Equidenpass) must be presented at the show office and be left there in case of overnight stays.
- Riders and owners are held responsible for damages, which their horses cause to third parties or to facilities of the organizer. In addition, any liability of the organizer for theft, spectators, riders/competitors, and horses, as well as tack and other material/equipment is excluded. In particular, participants are not agents in the sense of § 279 and § 831 BGB.
- Every horse owner and competitor upon entry or any accompanying person or visitor as they enter the event site, submits to the instructions and orders of the organizer and show management and acknowledges the rules of the American Quarter Horse Association (AQHA) and the National Reined Cow Horse Association (NRCHA).
- Participation is at your own risk. Parents are liable for any damages caused by their children.
- There is no contractual relationship between the organizer on the one hand and the visitors, horse owners and competitors in the show on the other hand.
- The organizer cannot be held responsible for late or lost entry forms.
- The organizer reserves the right to reject late entries - even for individual classes.
- Dogs must be leashed on the competition area.
- Distribution of prizes and refunds: The organizer is entitled to deduct any outstanding obligations of the participants. This also applies to the withholding tax according to § 50a para 4 income tax law for foreign horse owners. The following tax deduction will be made from the cash prizes: from 250 Euro up 15% and

an additional 5.5% solidarity supplement on the amount of tax deducted (costs of the competition will be taken into account). The tax deduction has to be confirmed upon request. Foreign horse owners not subject to tax withholding, can supply an exemption certificate with their entry, at the latest on the first day of the event. Participants are responsible for supplying the necessary complete and correct information.

- Each competitor is responsible for his or her correct membership in the AQHA/NRCHA and must make sure he or her is entitled to start in the relevant AQHA classes (level). Please check the relevant leveling on the AQHA website under <https://www.aqha.com/find-your-level>.
